## List of the Presidents of the board of trustees from the Fundación Colegio de N° S° de lana Antigua

As is known in the charter of the Foundation of Cardinal Rodrigo de Castro, among other things, he specified the following:

And he named the Lords of the house of Lemos starting with the Hon. Mr. Don Fernando Ruiz de Castro, who is presently present and continuing those who perpetually succeed him ahead....

We attach here the list of those who have been patrons of the Foundation made by Cardinal Rodrigo de Castro in 1593 and that continues to this day ...

## **CASTRO HOUSE**

- Fernando Ruiz de Castro Andrade y Portugal (1548-1601), VI Count of Lemos, III Marquis of Sarria, great of Spain and Viceroy of Naples (1599-1601).
- 2. Pedro Fernández de Castro y Andrade (1576-1622), VII count of Lemos, IV Marquis of Sarria, great of Spain, president of the Council of the Indies, viceroy of Naples (1610-1616) and president of the Supreme Council of Italy; \ "Great Count of Lemos \" \ "Honor of our Age \", great patron and personage of greater relevance and transcendence of his lineage. The nephew of Cardinal Rodrigo de Castro Osorio. He died without issue, so his lineage passed to his brother, the VIII Count of Lemos.
- 3. Francisco Ruiz de Castro Andrade y Portugal (1582-1637), VIII count of Lemos, V Marquis of Sarria, great of Spain and viceroy of Naples (1601-1603). In 1629, he renounced all his titles and possessions and entered the Sahagún monastery as a Benedictine monk, under the name of Frei Agustín de Castro.
- 4. Francisco Fernández de Castro (1613-1662), IX Count of Lemos, VI Marquis of Sarria, great of Spain.
- 5. **Pedro Antonio Fernández de Castro (1634-1667),** X count of Lemos, VII Marquis of Sarria, great of Spain, XXVII viceroy of Peru between 1667 and 1672, during the reign of Carlos II (1665-1700) of the House from Austria.
- 6. Ginés Miguel María de la Concepción Ruiz de Castro Andrade y Portugal Osorio (1666-1741), XI count of Lemos, IX count of Villalba and VIII Marquis of Sarria, great of Spain; he died without issue and his lineage passed to his niece Rosa María de Castro y Centurión.
- 7. **Rosa María de Castro y Centurión** (1691-1772), XII Countess of Lemos, IX Marchioness of Sarria, great of Spain. She died in 1772 without issue. After hereditary disputes between branches of the family, her title passes to her nephew, the Duke of Béjar.

8. Joaquín López de Zúñiga Sotomayor y Castro (1715-1777), XIII count of Lemos, X Marquis of Sarria, great of Spain. He dies without issue and with him the Casa de Castro is extinguished as hereditary of the County of Lemos, which passes together with the Marquisate of Sarria to the closest parental branch, the House of Berwick.

## **BERWICK HOUSE**

- 9. James Francis Edward Fitz-James Stuart and Ventura Colón de Portugal (1718-1785), XIV Count of Lemos, XI Marquis of Sarria, III Duke of Berwick and Grandee of Spain; he inherits the title by being the fourth net of Fernando Ruiz de Castro y Portugal (brother of the VII and VIII counts of Lemos). He married on July 26, 1738 with María Teresa da Silva and Álvarez de Toledo, daughter of the Dukes of Alba. He succeeds his son,
- 10. Carlos Fitz-James Stuart y Silva (1752-1787), XV Count of Lemos, XII Marquis of Sarria and great of Spain. He marries on September 15, 1771 with Carolina Augusta Stolberg and Hornes. He succeeds his son,
- 11. **Jacobo Fitz-James Stuart y Stolberg (1773-1794)**, XVI Count of Lemos, XIII Marquis of Sarria, III Duke of Berwick and Grandee of Spain. His son succeeds him,
- 12. Jacobo Fitz-James Stuart y Silva (1791-1794), XVII count of Lemos, XIV Marquis of Sarria, IV Duke of Berwick and great of Spain. He passed away at 3 years old. He is succeeded by his brother, Carlos Miguel Fitz-James Stuart y Silva (1794-1835), XVIII count of Lemos, XV Marquis of Sarria, V Duke of Berwick, XIV Duke of Alba and great of Spain. His son succeeds him,
- 13. Jacobo Luis Fitz-James Stuart y Sventimiglia (1821-1881), XIX Count of Lemos, XVI Marquis of Sarria, VINE Duke of Berwick, XIV Duke of Alba and Grandee of Spain. He marries Francisca de Palafox Portocarrero, IX Countess of Montijo, sister of Empress Eugenia. His son succeeds him,
- 14. Carlos María Fitz-James Stuart y Portocarrero (1849-1901), XX Count of Lemos, XVII Marquis of Sarria, VII Duke of Berwick, XVI Duke of Alba and Grandee of Spain. His son succeeds him,
- 15. **Jacobo Fitz-James Stuart y Falcó (1878-1953)**, XXI count of Lemos, XVIII Marquis of Sarria, XVII Duke of Alba, VIII Duke of Berwick and great of Spain. His only daughter succeeds him,
- 16. María del Rosario Cayetana Fitz-James Stuart y de Silva (1926-2014), XXII Countess of Lemos, XIX Marchioness of Sarria, IX Duchess of Berwick, XVIII Duchess of Alba and other titles, seventeen times great of Spain
- 17. Carlos Juan Fitz-James Stuart and Martínez de Irujo (1948-) Noble Spanish aristocrat XXIII Count of Lemos, XIX Duke of Alba, born in Madrid. He holds thirty-seven noble titles nine of them with greatness
